The ECB has developed an educational tool on price stability primarily aiming at pupils around the age of 15 living in the euro area. This educational tool will be presented in a toolbox consisting of one teachers' booklet, 40 pupils' leaflets, one video cassette, one DVD, one letter of presentation and one order form.

Tenderers shall make their own proposals (free choice of material) for the toolbox and send a sample, together with a sample of an additional packing (mailing box), to the ECB with their application. Tenderers are required to limit the size of the toolbox as far as possible creating a stable package into which all items can easily fit. All the items in the toolbox shall be efficiently packed and be easily accessible for the users.

The complete toolbox will be distributed to schools throughout the euro area or to national central banks on the basis of an ECB database.

The duration of the agreement with the ECB will be of 3 years with the possibility of renewal for a further period

up to 2 years.
