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adaptation of the vacancy notice to the newspaper format), to reserve space for advertisement in the international press, and to negotiate with such press the best possible prices and other conditions.

II.2) Quantity or scope of the contract

II.2.1) Total quantity or scope:

The core element of the contract consists of European-wide (27 EU Member States) advertisement of job vacancies, mainly in the press and on Internet portals. The types of services to be rendered can be summarised as follows:

- technical preparation: the agency should take care of all tasks linked to technical preparation,
- price negotiation: negotiate space and discounts in an effective manner and to ensure publication of vacancy notices in a timely manner,
- artwork: design a unique and attractive design (in line with the ECB's corporate identity),
- consulting: proactive advice and involvement on press media to be targeted, new developments on the market and indications on what other comparable institutions develop regarding their recruitment campaigns. In 2006, the ECB advertised a total of 40 vacancies. Similar quantities are expected for the coming years, although the ECB does not guarantee any particular volumes of work.

It is intended to initially contract for 3 years with the potential for a 1 year extension.

Tenders and all supporting documents must be priced in euro and all contract payments will be made in euro. All discussions and meetings will be conducted in English and no interpretation facilities will be provided.

The ECB reserves the right not to make any award and reserves the right to accept all or part of any tender unless the tenderer expressly stipulates otherwise in their tender. The ECB reserves the right to disqualify any applicant who provides information which proves to be incorrect.

Tenderers are also informed that site visits may be take place to confirm information in their offers.

Tenders will find details of the acceptability of submitting alternative offers in the invitation to tender document. Tenders may be rejected if the required information is not provided in the stated format at the time of tendering.
