The Services are expected to comprise the financial years 2017, 2018, 2019 and 2020. The tasks to be performed by the external examiner are based on international standard on assurance engagements (ISAE) N° 3402, and comprise a regular (annual) audit with the delivery of the ISAE 3402 (SOC2) Type II examination and related report and Ad hoc examinations. The T2S examination services will be performed both remotely at the external examiner's premises and on T2S sites. On site examinations visits are expected to take place at the ECB's premises in Frankfurt, as well as at the premises of the four Central Banks operating T2S (namely Banca d'Italia, Banco de España, Banque de France and Deutsche Bundesbank).
