The Eurotower is located in the city centre of Frankfurt. The Eurotower total rented surface in the building is around 60 000 m<sup>2</sup> and 2 513 896 kWh are estimated per year. The ECB requires regenerative (green) power supply and proof that the tenderer has supplied this kind of supply in the past as stated in the procurement documents. The local net operator is Netzdienste Rhein Main GmbH. In addition, the ECB is procuring the installation of stations to charge electric cars. The scope of service is further described in Annex 1 to this invitation-to-tender (ITT). The ECB intends to conclude a framework agreement with the successful Tenderer that is intended to become effective in January 2018 for the duration of 2 years.
