Execution of building works.

It is the intention of the European Central Bank (ECB) to build its new premises on the site of the former wholesale market hall (Großmarkthalle) in Frankfurt-on-Main. The design for the new ECB premises — by the Viennese architectural office Coop Himmelb(I)au — comprises 3 main elements: a 46-storey twisted double tower; the Großmarkthalle, with its new internal structures; and a steel and glass cantilever structure, which shall link the old market building to the high-rise towers and also provide a clearly identifiable main entrance from the north side of the site. The space between the 2 towers shall be completely enclosed to form a glazed atrium. The cantilever structure and a 'loop' bridge shall connect the atrium and the Großmarkthalle on several levels. The complex shall comprise the core of the new ECB premises and house the majority of the ECB's functions, providing around 2 300 office workplaces as well as a conference centre. The gross floor area of the buildings shall total 185 000 m<sup>2</sup>.

The construction works will be tendered as packages and lots, the main packages being:

- structural works,

- facades,
- building services,
- fitting-out,
- external works.

These packages will be further subdivided into lots in order to foster competition and to find specialist firms for each lot. The first packages/lots will be sent out to tender in 2009.

Tendering for the fitting-out, external works and parts of the building services will take place in 2010–11. Detailed descriptions of the packages and lots will be published with the respective contract notices. The contract notices will appear in the OJ and on the ECB's website (http://www.ecb.europa.eu/ecb/jobsproc/proc/tenders/html/index.en.html), as well as on the special NEP procurement website (www.tender.new-ecb-premises.com, www.ausschreibung.ezb-neubau.de), which will be launched at the beginning of February 2009 with the start of procurement.
