Overview of milestones due in 2020



Current reporting milestones

Three milestones were to be met by 31 March 2020:

- > IAD4: Drafting of internal applications documentation is completed
- > IAD5: Software development for the required adaptation changes to T2 is started
- > NSP3: Network service provider selection and contract preparation is completed
- Given the current situation of mobility restrictions due to COVID-19 pandemic, the banking community agreed in the AMI-Pay call on 3 April 2020 to postpone the deadline for the completion of the NSP3 milestone to 31 July 2020, to fall together with the NSP4 milestone.
- Feedback from NCBs on the milestones' status were received on 14 April 2020.

Highlights from the Community Readiness Report

Overall readiness status: the reporting shows a decrease of the overall confidence level for both NCBs and their communities

National Central Banks (NCBs):

- **28% Green confidence level:** 7 out of 25 reported Green compared to 18 in last reporting
- 72% Yellow confidence level: 18 out of 25 reported Yellow compared to 7 in last reporting
- No NCB reported a Red confidence level

Closely Monitored Participants (CMPs):

- 53% Green confidence level:74 out of 139 reported Green compared to 104 in last reporting
- 42% Yellow confidence level: 58 out 139 reported Yellow compared to 24 in last reporting
- For the first time **5% Red confidence level:** 7 reported Red compared to 0 in last reporting

Regularly Monitored Participants (RMPs):

- 29% Green confidence level: 628 out of 2135 reported Green
- 62% Yellow and Red confidence level: 1287 reported Yellow and 31 Red out of 2135
- 9% did not report: 189 out of 2135

Main reasons for the decrease in the confidence level

- The current situation of the COVID-19 pandemic and its related consequences (e.g. need for reprioritisation of certain activities, teleworking conditions, project resources moved to production); and
- The SWIFT's announcement to delay the ISO 20022 implementation in cross-border business until 2022.

Completion of milestones IAD4 & IAD5



- IAD5: 13 NCBs (52%) and 70 CMPs (50%) confirmed having started their software development for the required adaptation changes to T2
- IAD4: 7 NCBs (28%) and 61 CMPs (44%) confirmed completing the drafting of their internal applications documentation

Proposal on repositioning the NSP4 milestone

- Given the current situation of mobility restrictions due to COVID-19 pandemic, and that
- There is buffer for repositioning the NSP4 milestone (Network Service Provider procurement is completed), originally due by 31 July 2020, without impacting any of the forthcoming key milestones, in particular the start of the connectivity testing by market participants (NCO1) in December 2020

> AMI-Pay members are invited to agree:

- To ease the fulfilment of the NSP4 milestone, and that
- The new deadline for the completion of the NSP4 milestone is 31 October 2020

Next Steps

- In the 9th MTRSG meeting on 20 21 April 2020, it was agreed not to pursue the proposal of having an additional reporting cycle as interim status update between the current and forthcoming reporting cycle.
- The forthcoming reporting cycle is due by 31 July which includes milestones IAD7, NSP3 and NSP4 (pending the AMI-Pay endorsement of the proposal for repositioning the NSP4).
- The ECB will continue the dialogue with the Central banks to support them and their communities in their readiness process for the go-live of the T2-T2S Consolidation project.
