

# **User Detailed Functional Specifications (UDFS)**

- After validating all iterations, UDFS was consolidated and submitted for consultation with other Eurosystem committees
- Ready to be approved by the MIB in December. UDFS will serve as a basis for internal development.

## Readiness framework

 Aims at assessing the ability of relevant actors to interact with the ECMS at the go-live date and to ensure the successful big-bang migration. ECMS readiness is distinct from CMH monitoring of (harmonisation) market standards readiness.

 Next steps: Eurosystem NCBs will align on the readiness questionnaire and milestones. Details to be shared with market participants once finalised.
