
#### T2-T2S Consolidation - governance



- Target Consolidation Contact Group (TCCG) (Central Bank and Banks composition)
  - Since the last AMI-Pay meeting, the TCCG held three meetings mostly concentrated around the functional specifications and three workshops dedicated to RTGS and CLM GUI
  - All meeting documentation is available on the ECB website

#### T2-T2S Consolidation – current status (2/4)




- Delivery of User Detailed Functional Specifications (UDFS) v2.0
  - Market consultation on the version 1.1 was completed by 05 April (11 weeks)
  - TCCG Written procedure on messages in MyStandards was completed by 22 April (4 weeks);
  - Received feedback (~ 1200 comments) will be implemented in the UDFS v2.0
  - Following the MIB approval, UDFS v2.0 will be shared with the TCCG on 1 July 2019, followed by the publication on the ECB website;
  - UDFS v2.0 will become the baseline version.



#### T2-T2S Consolidation – current status (3/4)



- GUI screens and User Handbook
  - CLM and RTGS GUI workshops with market participants were held on 15 January 2019, 13 March 2019 and 12 April 2019; further discussions will continue in Q3-2019;
  - Work on the **User Handbook** is planned to start in January 2020 after the start of the GUI screens development, following the outcome of the GUI workshops;



#### T2-T2S Consolidation – current status (4/4)



- ESMIG connectivity
  - The first stage of the concession award procedure is completed, with two network service providers submitting their bids
  - If awarded concessions, SIA-COLT and SWIFT will be allowed to offer connectivity to all Eurosystem market infrastructure services via a Single Market Infrastructure Gateway (ESMIG)
