Central Bank Testing (CBT)

- CBT progress below expectation due to blocking issues, which were addressed,
 Yellow allowing CBs to speed up their test campaigns from the second half of October onwards.
- On 30 November 2021, mandatory test cases completion was on average at 94% (up from 90%).
 Average overall test completion is at 55% (up from 49%).

User Testing (UT)

- The MIB concluded on the overall readiness and confirmed the start of User Testing on 1 December 2021.
- □ The User Testing started officially on 1 December 2021.
 - CBs are currently capturing their reference data and the reference data of their participants.
 - Each CB will communicate to their participants when they can access CRDM.
 - Once the reference data in CRDM are configured and liquidity has been distributed then participants can start testing CLM and RTGS.
- Upcoming focus session on User Testing on 19 January 2022.
