



Query for Statement of Account admi.005 vs. admi.006

Background

Two user requirements are dealing with querying for the statement of accounts (camt.053)

- RTGS.UR.RTGS.UI.110
- CLM.UR.CLM.UI.050
- "RTGS/CLM shall provide the functionality to query on the account/MCA statement"
- Initial 4CB approach to fulfill these URs was to use the admi.006 (ResendRequest)
- Rationale for that decision:
 - camt.053 only provided at end of day as a full report
 - camt.053 only provided in push mode (4CB interpretation of URDs)

Because of these rationales resending the camt.053 was seen as the best solution to fulfill the URs



New approach

During the drafting of UDFS v0.3 the 4CB came to the conclusion that camt.053 will be provided in both push and pull mode

- Therefore admi.006 is not appropriate as
 - it cannot retrieve camt.053 that have not been sent out
 - admi.006 is not a query message but more a technical one
 - admi.006 supports technical selection criteria, therefore URs cannot me mapped completely

4CB analysis showed that admi.005 (ReportQueryRequest) is the most appropriate message to fulfill the URs

With admi.005 the customer can query for the latest version of the full statement of account report, independent from the report configuration (push/pull)

- Admi.005 is also used within T2S for the same purpose
- Admi.005 business and message are established, and foreseen for ISO registration



Current status & way forward

4CB have created and customized the admi.005 together with SWIFT Standard Experts

4CB and ECB have performed a consultation of the message drafting group

- No doubt received on the usage of admi.005
- No comment/need for change received for the customized message
- Admi.005 will be included in UDFS v0.4
